Tasting notes:

Deep bright red colour.

Aromas of cherries, raspberries, strawberries and plums with subtle earthiness (forest floor). Consider the "Pinot Noir version" of Pinotage. A sensation of fresh lively tannins with a smooth, mouthwatering finish.

Flavours of red cherries and sour plums with some earthy notes.

Food Pairing:

Beef lasagna, roast turkey, pork or venison stew.

Blend:

Pinotage 100%

Vinification:

Grapes are harvested when phenolic ripeness, soft fruit tannins and fruit aromas have reached the perfect balance. Modern winemaking techniques are applied to maximize freshness and bring out the fruity aromas that are typical to the varietal.
